Consultant

1. What is a ATMAE Consultant?

A ATMAE Consultant is an individual who is thoroughly familiar with accreditation standards, has served as a chair of at least two visiting accreditation teams and has recently attended visiting team training. As a result, this individual can assist an institution in preparing for the ATMAE accreditation process.

2. Why would I want a ATMAE Consultant?

If you would like to have a pre-accreditation review of your program(s)/options(s), or assistance in developing your self-study you may want a ATMAE Consultant.

3. How much does it cost?

The cost is \$500.00 per day plus actual travel expenses. There may one additional day charge for each day on-site for report writing.

4. How do I ask for a Consultant?

Go to the ATMAE web site and fill out a Consultant Request form. Send it to the attention of the ATMAE Executive Director. You can then select from the Personnel section of the web a consultant of your choice or ask that a consultant be assigned by the ATMAE Personnel Committee.
