

2009 ATMAE Outstanding Industrial Technologist Award Award Criteria, Selection and Nomination Process



Award: The Outstanding Industrial Technologist Award is presented annually by the ATMAE Industry Division to graduates of ATMAE (NAIT) -accredited Industrial Technology programs. The Industry Division will recognize one Outstanding Industrial Technologists in 2009.

Selection: Institutions with ATMAE-accredited programs are invited to nominate an individual graduate. The Industry Division President determines if nominees meet the criteria for the award and selects the awardees

Criteria: Each nominee must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Graduate of a program that is currently ATMAE accredited.
- 2) Graduated at least ten years ago.
- 3) Held progressively more responsible positions in business, industry, or government and **must be currently employed in a position that significantly affects the success of the organization.** (It is not the intent of this award program to recognize individual contributors or entrepreneurs who are self-employed or who have associated with several others to provide a service.)
- 4) Nominated by an institution with programs that are currently ATMAE-accredited.
- 5) **Nominations for 2009 awards must reach the Chair of the ATMAE Outstanding Industrial Technologist Award Selection Committee no later than August 4, 2009.**
- 6) **Nominees must attend the ATMAE convention to receive the award.**

Note: ATMAE membership is not required for nomination.

Award Recognition Components:

- 1) A personalized plaque presented by the Industry Division of ATMAE that identifies the award, the individual, and the nominating institution.
- 2) Complimentary one-year membership in ATMAE.
- 3) Complimentary registration for the 2009 ATMAE Convention, including tickets for the awardee and a limited number of guests (3) for the ATMAE event at which award is presented.

Presentation of the Award: The 2009 Outstanding Industrial Technologist Awards will be presented at the 2009 Annual Convention in Nashville, Tennessee at the ATMAE Awards Banquet on Friday November 21, 2009.

Nominations: Nominations are solicited from the Deans, Chairs and Department Heads of all institutions with ATMAE-Accredited Programs. Individuals may also nominate themselves. Each nomination must include the following (see nomination form):

- 1) Name, address, telephone and email address of the nominee;
- 2) Major program completed and year of graduation;
- 3) History of employment indicating progressively responsible positions; and
- 4) A brief description of the nominee's current position and how this position impacts the success of the organization;
- 5) If possible, an acknowledgment that the nominee would attend to accept their award.
