

**The 2010 ATMAE Faculty Excellence Awards:**  
**- Community/Technical College Faculty Award  
for Academic Excellence**  
**- University Faculty Award for Academic Excellence**



**Nomination Deadline: September 1, 2010**

**Scope:** ATMAE may confer Academic Faculty Excellence Awards upon up to three ATMAE members from two-year institutions and up to three members from four-year institutions, including graduate faculty. Awardees should have a demonstrated record of excellence and achievement in their profession. These awards are sponsored by Goodheart-Willcox Publisher.

The **Community/Technical College Faculty Award for Academic Excellence** is for members having primary responsibilities in two-year institutions offering technology, applied engineering, or engineering technology programs, and selection is based on excellence in teaching and service to the profession.

The **University Faculty Award for Academic Excellence** is for members having primary responsibilities in four-year institutions offering technology, engineering technology, technology management or applied engineering programs, and selection is based on excellence in teaching, research, and service to the profession.

**The Award:** Each recipient is presented a plaque (sponsored by Goodheart-Willcox Publisher) at the annual conference.

**Membership Prerequisite:** An individual must be a current ATMAE member at the time the award is given.

**Nominations and Criteria:** To nominate a faculty member for the ATMAE Academic Excellence Award:

- Submit the individual's name, resume, cover letter, and other materials relevant to the selection criteria to the Chair of the of the Academic Excellence Awards Committee Chair (see p. 2)
- Community/Technical College selection criteria shall address excellence in 1) teaching and 2) service to the profession.
- University selection criteria shall address excellence in 1) teaching, 2) research, and 3) service to the profession.
- An individual may nominate herself or himself for the award.
- The cover letter should highlight the nominee's major accomplishments over the *last three* academic years.
- *Nomination deadline is September 1, 2010.*

**2010 Procedure:** The process of identification of candidates, evaluation of credentials and selection of recipients will conclude by September 1, 2010.

**1. Chair of the ATMAE Executive Board:**

- Use ATMAE media – newsletter, Web site, listserv, and specialized emails - to solicit nominations.
- Review the criteria and procedure for the award.
- Encourage Division Presidents to seek nominations and move the selection process forward.
- Appoint a selection committee chair from the Executive Board by March 1

**2. The Selection Committee**

- The selection committee chair will form a committee comprised of at least two (2) other ATMAE members. The others members should fairly represent two-year and four-year institutions. At least

one of committee members must be a previous award winner. The total number of people serving on the committee should be no more than five (5), including the chair.

- **Nominations will be closed on September 1, 2010.**
- The selection committee will review and rank the submissions; making a final selection using the cumulative ranking for each nominee.
- **SELECTION DEADLINE:** The selection committee will report the names of selected recipients to the ATMAE Associate Director by **September 15** so that award plaques and other materials can be produced in time for the ATMAE 2010 annual conference.
- The award recipient's identity should be kept confidential except to inform the recipients to ensure they will be present to receive the award.
